


## Installing a keypad

- 1. Choose the location you wish to install your keypad. The keypad must be installed on a flat surface that is at least 5" long by 1 1/2" wide. Be careful when choosing your location so that there are no wires or pipes that can be cut or pierced.
- 2. Cover the surface to be drilled with masking tape. (At least 6" by 2")
- 3. Drill two 7/8" holes 3 1/8" apart.
- 4. Cut out the excess material between the two holes with a fine tooth saw or a jigsaw.
- Apply silicone to the underside of the keypad and insert the keypad into the opening.
- 6. Protect the keypad with a piece of wood when clapping the keypad in place. Let dry for at least 24 hours.
- 7. Plug in the keypad wire and test that all the buttons are working.
